Forty two standard white earthenware shards of which nine, and three, conjoin, from a minimum of three cups and a saucer. They are all decorated with two painted fine grey bands below the rim, and a band of blue and grey stylized flowers. The saucer has a flat base with an everted edge; the glaze has traces of cobalt.
